### Background

UrbanVirons Group is one of the leading weed, environmental and horticultural maintenance companies in South Australia, servicing commercial and government properties, mainly.

### Results

Time sheet and project data is uploaded automatically from GPS TimeTrack to payroll and invoicing applications, eliminating paper time cards and office staff data entry. Proposals for new business now have more accurate job-costing information and web-based maps showing the real-time location of field staff enable dispatchers to route the nearest workers to the next jobs.

### Challenge

To automate job-costing and time sheet capture, and improve field staff routing and dispatching.

### Solution

UrbanVirons Group has deployed GPS TimeTrack to 55 mobile workers, who use the phone-based application to record time sheet and project data, including when they begin and end a shift or project, and what materials were used. UrbanVirons Group also is using maps generated by GPS TimeTrack to route and dispatch field staff to new assignments.
